





Installation

1. Remove Sliding Panes

- A Gently lift the front sliding pane and pull the bottom of the pane out and free of the bottom track.
- B Move the pane down and free of the top track.
- C Place the pane somewhere where it will not get broken or scratched.
- D Repeat with the other pane.





2. Install the Frame

- A Install the frame as you would a panel. (See Panel Installation Instructions for more details).
- B Verify the panel is square.

3. Reinsert the Sliding Panes

- A Identify the back pane the handle and edge stiffener are attached on opposite sides of the pane
- B Reorient the back pane when looking at the smooth side of the frame, the handle should face you and be on the right side of the pane.
- C Reinsert the top of the back pane into the middle groove on the top track.
- D Rotate the bottom of the pane into position over the same groove of the bottom track.
- E Gently set the pane back down into the bottom track.
- F Slide the pane to the closed position with the handle nearest the frame.
- G Insert the front pane, with the handle on the left and facing you, into the front groove of the tracks using the same method.





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
