

1 YEAR LIMITED WARRANTY

This limited 1 (one) year warranty DOES NOT COVER the following:

- 1. Defects or damage arising from shipping, installation, alterations, accidents, abuse, misuse, lack of proper maintenance and use of other than genuine Subzero replacement parts, in all cases whether caused by a contractor, service company, the owner or any other person.
- 2. Deterioration through normal wear and tear.
- 3. Damages resulting from abuse or misuse from failure to install or maintain this product in accordance with the written instructions furnished by Subzero Engineering.
- 4. Use of Cleaning Products Containing Calcium Hypo Chlorite (Chlorine), Scouring Powders or pads shall not be covered.
- 5. Expense of normal maintenance.
- 6. All costs of removal, transportation, labor, reinstallation or other costs including postage and/or shipping costs to obtain warranty service shall be paid by the customer.





A left and right door panel, as well as a left and right hinge post, will be included if a Dual Hinged Door is ordered.



Right hand door shown. Actual product may vary from what is shown.




1 - ASSEMBLE THE FRAME

- ☐ Lay the posts and header on the floor with the gasket and hinges facing up.
- ☐ Push the header into place over the panel inserts.
- ☐ The t-nuts on either end must line up with the vertical running t-slots on the posts.




2 - FASTEN THE FRAME

- ☐ Fasten the door frame together using a 5mm hex key.
- ☐ Fasten each end of the header in the locations shown.



3 - ATTACHING THE FEET

- ☐ Attach the feet to the posts using the hardware shown.
- ☐ Tighten Item # E using the 4mm hex key.




4 - STAND THE FRAME UP

- ☐ Stand the door frame up.
- ☐ Move the door frame in front of the server cabinets or wherever its desired position may be.
- ☐ Ensure that the smooth face of the door frame is facing you as you look into the aisle.




Two people are required to stand the door into position.




5 - POSITION THE DOOR

- ☐ Move the door frame to the left or right and determine where it is to be placed.
- ☐ Typically, the door frame should be centered on the aisle.
- ☐ Make sure the area is free from obstructions and mark lightly on the floor where the door frame is to be installed.




6 - SQUARE THE DOOR FRAME

- ☐ Measure as shown in the figure.
- ☐ Adjust the frame until the two measurements are equal.



7 - LEVEL THE DOOR FRAME

- ☐ Ensure that the door frame is standing at 90 degrees to the floor.
- ☐ Adjust the bottom or the top of the door frame out as needed.




8 - DRILL PILOT HOLES

- ☐ Drill pilot holes for mounting the door frame in the locations shown.
- ☐ Use a powered drill and a 1/4" bit.



Use a vacuum while drilling to ensure that particulates do not enter server equipment.



9 - FASTEN THE FRAME DOWN


☐ Using a drill, 1/2" deep socket, and Item # D, fasten the frame down in the 2 locations where pilot holes were drilled.



Raised floor installation shown.



If a concrete installation kit was selected, Item # D will be replaced with concrete screws and should be installed in the same fashion.



10 - SECURE TO THE CABINETS


- ☐ Attach Item # A to the frame as shown.
- ☐ If no existing holes can be utilized, use Item # F, a drill, and a 3/8" socket to self tap into the server cabinet frame.
- ☐ Repeat the above steps on the left and right sides of the door frame.



Use a vacuum while using self tapping screws to ensure that particulates do not enter server equipment.




There are many ways to secure to the server cabinet. Make sure you select a method appropriate for your environment.




11 - HANG THE DOOR PANEL

☐ Hang the door panel on the frame hinges.




12 - CONTINUED

- ☐ Swing the door open and closed until the hinges align properly.
- ☐ Ensure that the hinges are fully seated before continuing.




13 - SET THE SPRING HINGE

- ☐ Open the door 5 to 15 degrees.
- ☐ Remove the hinge cap.
- ☐ Using a small mallet, tap the spring pin (#L) into the hinge.




14 - REMOVE THE SET PIN

- ☐ Open the door 30 degrees or more.
- ☐ Using a flat head screwdriver, carefully pry the set pin out of the hinge.
- ☐ Push the set pin into the pin holder on the bottom of the hinge cap.




15 - ADJUST CLOSING SPEED

- ☐ Remove the damper cap.
- ☐ Using a Phillips head screwdriver, adjust the closing speed to meet your needs.



16 - FINISHED

FOR DUAL HINGED DOOR: REPEAT THE ABOVE STEPS FOR THE LEFT AND RIGHT DOORS.



OPERATION
☐ Do not slam the door shut.
☐ Do not open the door using excessive force.
☐ Do not hang on the door while open.
CLEANING - PANEL INSERT
☐ Use a soft cloth, mild detergent, and water.
☐ Do not use any abrasive pads or materials.
☐ Do not use harsh solvents or thinners.
